This snapshot takes a peek.





Tickets sales trends to Christmas Shows in 2017



November is, unsurprisingly, the peak month for ticket sales, generating 24% of all revenue in 2017.

Overall, sales begin climbing rapidly from mid-September.


When do audiences book to see Christmas Shows?

Though number of performances are almost equal, Pantomimes attracted 60% more bookers, buying twice as many tickets and generating over twice as much income as other Christmas Shows. Venue size is a factor here, so we'll be watching the trends to see how they develop.

For 51% of people who booked for a Christmas Show or Pantomime in 2017, it was the only theatrical performance they attended that financial year.
